YEAR GROUP	CURRICULUM OUTCOME	RECCOMENDED ACTIVITIES
YEAR 7	ACHCK048	What would Australia's Constitution look like if a group of women had written it? What would it say? Would it have a bill of rights attached? What would this say?
YEAR 8	ACHCK061	In pairs, research women's voting rights in Australia. Look at petitions to parliament, protests, and significant changes to federal legislation. Identify notable Australian women's achievements.
YEAR 9	ACHCK075	Research Julia Gillard's hung parliament in 2010. What happened? Who were the two parties involved and the two leaders? What is a hung parliament? What date was election day? How many seats did each party win? Who held the balance of power?
